A once in a lifetime experience for boat enthusiasts and those who have always wanted to cruise the archipelago of the sheltered waters off the east coast of **Vancouver Island**. This tour is for the adventurer who can leave the comforts of home behind in exchange for some of the most spectacular scenery that can be experienced from a ship.

What's the catch? We won't be staying at one of our customary 4 - 5 star resorts. In fact, this tour is onboard a 135 foot working vessel that transports a wide variety of heavy equipment and general freight throughout the **Gulf of Georgia**, the remote inlets of **Johnstone** and **Queen Charlotte Straits** and **Broughton Archipelago**.

Passenger accommodations are premium staterooms with twin beds and forward viewing windows or standard staterooms equipped with bunk beds. There are six shared washrooms, three shower rooms and an adjacent washer/dryer.

For those willing to rough it a bit this cruise will bring you to places like 'Ripple Rock', **Seymour Narrows**, **Discovery Passage**, **Johnstone Strait**, **Kingcome** and **Knight Inlets** and **Wakeman Sound** to name a few, and although freight opportunities



dictate actual "ports of call" the **Aurora Explorer** travels deep into the coastal fjords. No matter what route our tour takes the Aurora Explorer makes every effort to stop near the historic first nations villages of **Mamailaculla** and **Karlukwees**, as well time permitting the captain is known to be a regular visitor at **Yorke Island**, the sobering historic military site that housed WWII artillery defences.

So pack a good pair of deck shoes and layered clothing and be prepared to view unparalleled scenery and wildlife that includes **whales, porpoises, seals, sea lions** and **eagles**.
