21 Meals - 13 nights & 14 days

Day One: *Vancouver – Lincoln City* **Meals: D**
 Depart from Canada and travel south through the state of **Washington** into **Oregon** for a one night stay at the deluxe waterfront **Inn at Spanish Head** in **Lincoln City**. Dinner is served at the hotel.

Day Two: *Lincoln City – Gold Beach* **Meals: B, D**
 After breakfast travel along the beautiful **Oregon Coast** with its spectacular shorelines outlined by ocean breakers and stunning beaches protected by rocky headlands and miles of sand dunes. Arrive late afternoon at the beachfront **Gold Beach Resort** for a two night stay.

Day Three: *Gold Beach* **Meals: B, L**
 This day promises to be an exciting one. Journey 32 miles upriver through the scenic portion of the **Rogue River Canyon** on a specially designed “**Hydro Jet**” vessel. This area abounds in wildlife, rugged canyon scenery and exciting shallow riffles. You will be thrilled with tall tales of river history and folklore.

Day Four: *Gold Beach – Ukiah* **Meals: B, L**
 Say goodbye to the Oregon Coast and hello to the **Redwood forests** known as the “**Avenue of the Giants.**” A hosted lunch at the **Samoa Cookhouse** near **Eureka** is on today's agenda en route to **Ukiah**.

Day Five: *Ukiah – San Francisco* **Meals: B**
 Wind your way through California's northern wine region with a stop at a magnificent overlook of **San Francisco**, your home for the next two nights. On the way stop in **Sonoma Wine Country** for wine tasting. Cross the bay on the famous **Golden Gate Bridge** as you enter the “**City by the Bay.**” The hotel is located just two blocks away from **Fisherman's Wharf at Pier 39**.

Day Six: *San Francisco* **Meals: B**
 This morning there is free time at **Fisherman's Wharf** to shop and visit the many galleries and exhibits. This afternoon an experienced guide will introduce you to the history and splendour of this unique bay metropolis. Included are the historic **Cliff House, Chinatown, Twin Peaks** and other historic sites with various stops.

Day Seven: *San Francisco – Monterey* **Meals: B, D**
 An optional **Cable Car** ride begins the day, then it's off to **Monterey** via the **Pacific Coast Highway**, which has plenty of picture stops along the way. Arrive mid-afternoon in **Monterey** for a two night stay at the **Monterey Victorian Inn** located in the heart of **Cannery Row**. Tonight's dinner is at **Monterey's Fisherman's Wharf**.

Day Eight:
Monterey – Carmel – Monterey
Meals: B
 Depart for the famous **Cannery Row** followed by a visit to the world famous **17-Mile Drive** with photo stops,

including the **Lone Cypress** and **Pebble Beach**, before arriving at the storybook village of **Carmel**. Here you'll have time to browse the charming galleries, boutiques and shops of this one square-mile town. Travel back to the inn and enjoy the evening on your own or with your friends.



Day Nine: Monterey – Santa Barbara Meals: B

An early start today takes you along the stunning **Big Sur Coastal Road** to **Hearst Castle**. There is time for lunch before a guided tour of the **Casa Grande, Neptune & Roman pools, Esplanade and Gardens**. After the visit to the castle continue south to the **Hotel Santa Barbara** in the heart of downtown **Santa Barbara** for your two night stay.

Day Ten: Santa Barbara – Solvang – Santa Barbara Meals: B, D

Today visit historic **Solvang**, named by *Sunset* magazine as one of the "10 Most Beautiful Small Towns in the Western United States." Solvang's rich heritage dates back to 1911 when adventurous Danish-Americans traversed the plains from Iowa to establish a settlement in the golden state of California. Explore this historic town at leisure. After lunch return to Santa Barbara for some free time followed by dinner at the **Harbor Restaurant** on the pier.

Day Eleven: Santa Barbara – San Diego Meals: B, L

Stop at the historic **San Juan Capistrano Mission** where lunch is served at the **El Adobe Capistrano** restaurant followed by a guided tour of this beautiful old Mission. Enjoy the scenic coastal road to the **Best Western Hacienda Plus Hotel**, steps from **Old Town San Diego**, your home for three nights.

Day Twelve: San Diego Meals: B

Enjoy a day tour of San Diego at your own pace using the included ticket for the "hop-on-hop-off" **old town trolley**. Stay on for a full 90 minute tour listening to a knowledgeable conductor, or hop off at any of the points of interest such as the historic **Hotel Coronado** and hop back on to a later trolley.

Day Thirteen: San Diego Meals: B, D

Explore the **San Diego Zoo**, renowned as one of the best zoos in the world and one of the foremost leaders in conservation.

Day Fourteen: San Diego – Vancouver Meals: B

All good things must come to an end, so today we say "Goodbye California". Depart by plane for Vancouver with memories of the Oregon and California Coasts.
